


### ARTIST STATEMENT:

The foundation for the creation of my art is the focus of architecture.

Space and the world surrounding figures appearing in my drawings are not captivated by the frame of reality. It may draw from reality, but in some part it is always a fantasy. In other words, it is the encounter of reality and my vision, whose interpretation I leave to the recipient.

In my drawings, I use repetitions in order to create an atmosphere through addition of various colors, that change the perception of the content, and accent different details of the artwork. So the resulting series completes my statement.

Created works I call "the architecture of desire" - because as a result of it – uninhibited need of creation they come to existence. They come into a world where everything is possible...









# "THREE SPIRITS" DESIGN (head designer)


"Three Spirits," are a floating tourist base and hotel in the form of three ships. Each of the three ships functions as an independent unit and is designed for 30 days of self-sufficiency.

The ships making up a complex ,to a certain degree, differ as for the applied program. If the appropriate localization is chosen, they may form the common assumption - an island "Lang". Guests can then benefit from the broader scale of supplementary attractions. On the first ship they have a ballroom at their disposal, on the second one - a casino and on the third one - the hall of multifunctional purposes where, inter alia, film shows and theatrical performances are possible. When the ships "meet" they generate a common water area for guests to swim. One of the main attractions of a particular ship is a diving capsule. Guests can not only practice scuba diving but also they can dive safely in significant depth to see ,for example coral reefs or wrecks. The set of boats is also delivered for guests, and it enables them to choose an appropriate place for recreation, among other things also for scuba diving during the stopover of the ship.

Since each ship is a separate unit there is a possibility of temporary separation of the "vessels" ("vehicles") in order to carry out different cruises and afterwards a possibility of ships meeting again...









## "NEBULA" DESIGN

A task created by the organizers targets at finding a method of promoting a great investment of building a tunnel connecting two continents. A link will clear a great transport movement in the oceans and congestion in harbors and it will cause an easier and cheaper transport of goods and mineral deposit. The tunnel also would, in organizers' opinion, cross the zones of time, history, ideology and politics.


The idea of connecting the continents with an underground tunnel, creating a peace memorial in the halfway and emphasizing the line of the international change of date gave us the chance of creating a visionary conception called Nebula Park.


Nebula Park will become the place of information processing into an external illumination and this way it becomes a barometer of the Earth and the global mood. Only peace and balance will keep Nebula Park as a place of reconciliation. Time itself will show whether this design will be Nebula or not Mirage.




### Jury opinion:


"The jury unanimously fund that this project represented one of the most successful and unconventional versions of the Symbolic Geometric approach. While it recalls such a visionary 18th century projects like Ledoux's Cenotaph, by rethinking the sphere as a dematerialized nebula. Streams of energy tunnel through the bedrock and erupt to form a geyser of light composed of colorful intertwined glowing cords enclosed within a latticed geodesic sphere. The jury especially commended the capacity of this team's stunning and original renderings to express their outrageous vision of global unity and world peace".

Between 1987-1996 Filip Kurzewski drawings were the designs to his mother's unique tapestries (Jolanta Pachowska - graduate of the Academy of Fine Arts in Warsaw). These works were exhibited, in Poland, Austria, Finland, Germany and in many cities in the USA, where they were published by numerous prestigious magazines. Exhibitions presented in USA happened to be a huge success, as a result the tapestries were sold to prestigious private collections.
















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
